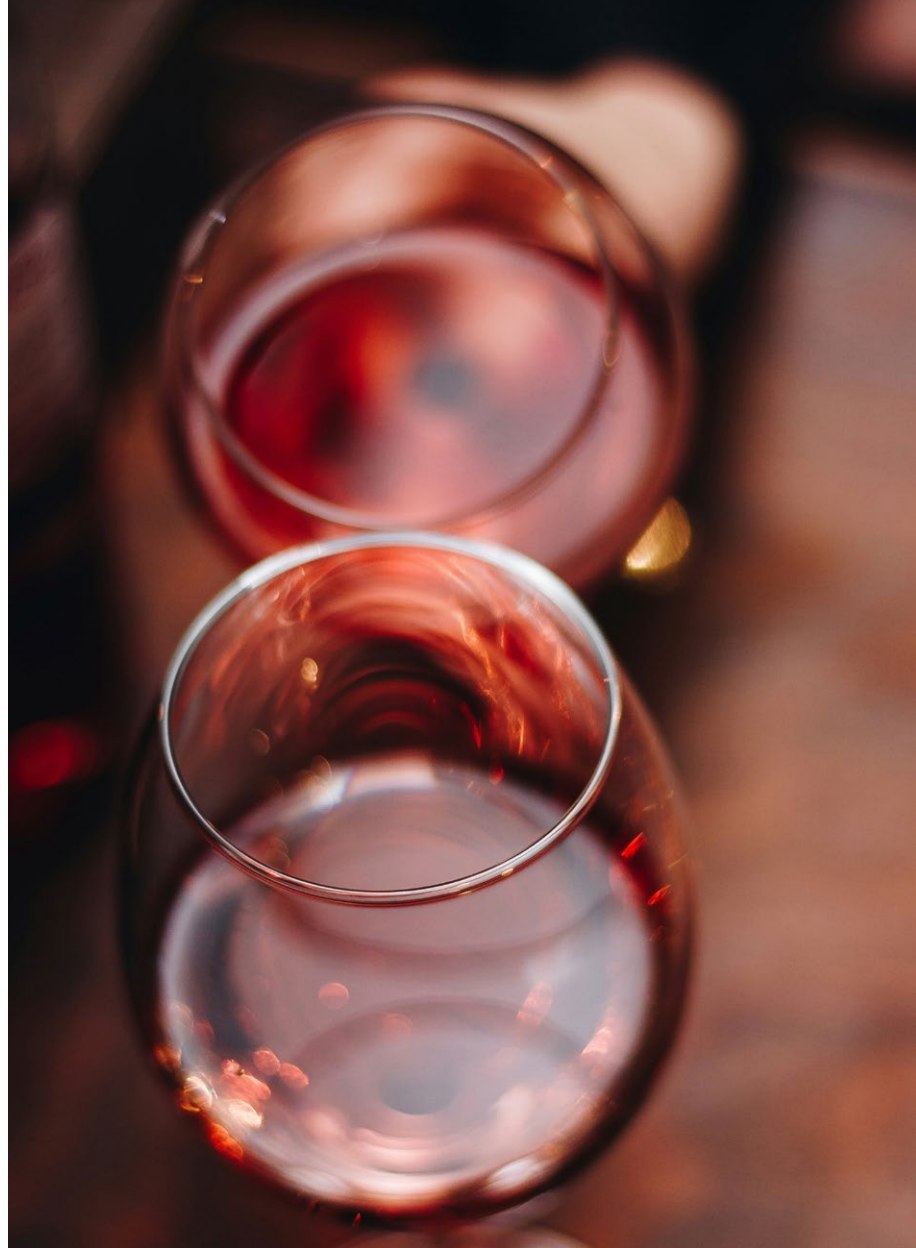

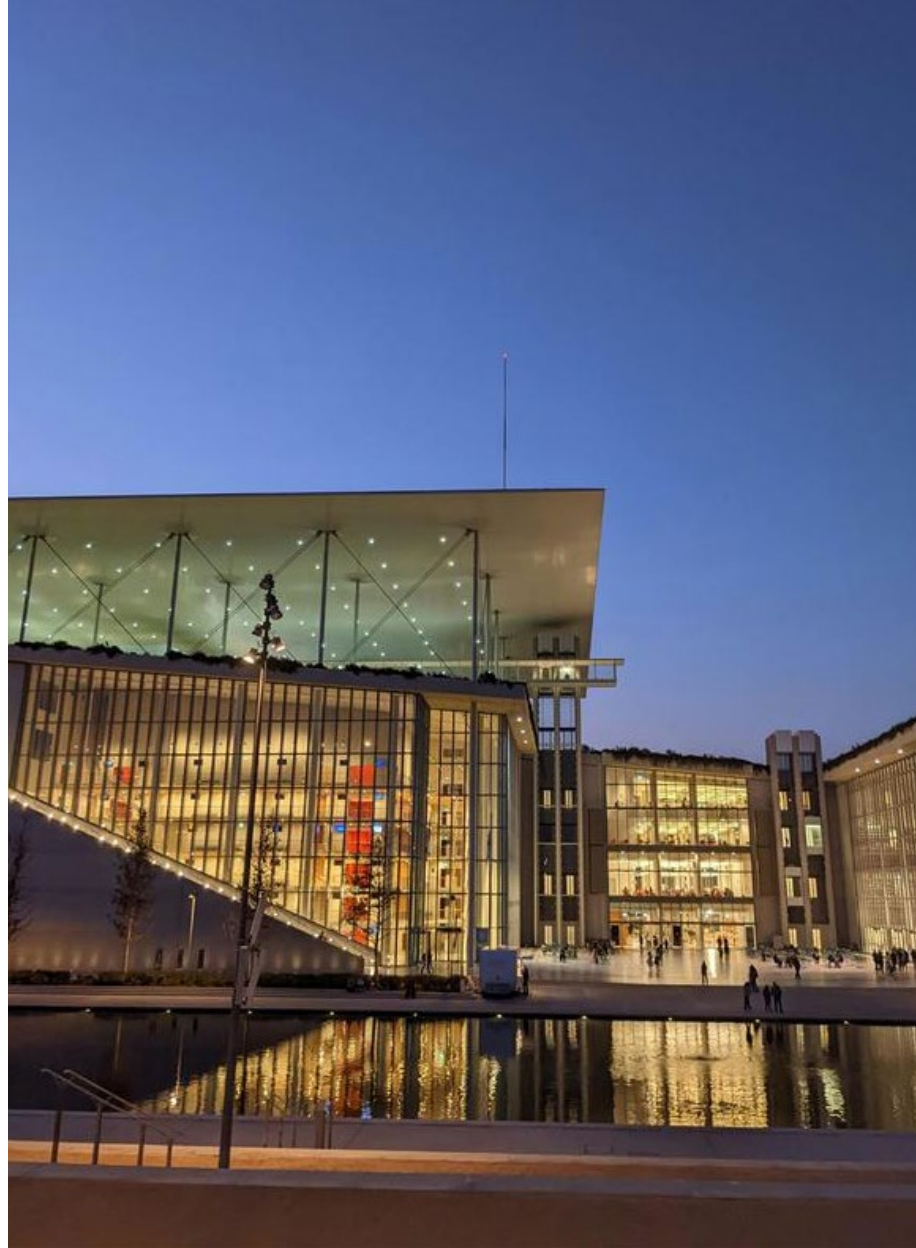

Nestled on Ermou Street, the 11th-century Kapnikarea church stands atop ancient temple ruins. Modest yet historic, its Byzantine form and fading frescoes reflect the enduring spirit of medieval Athens.
